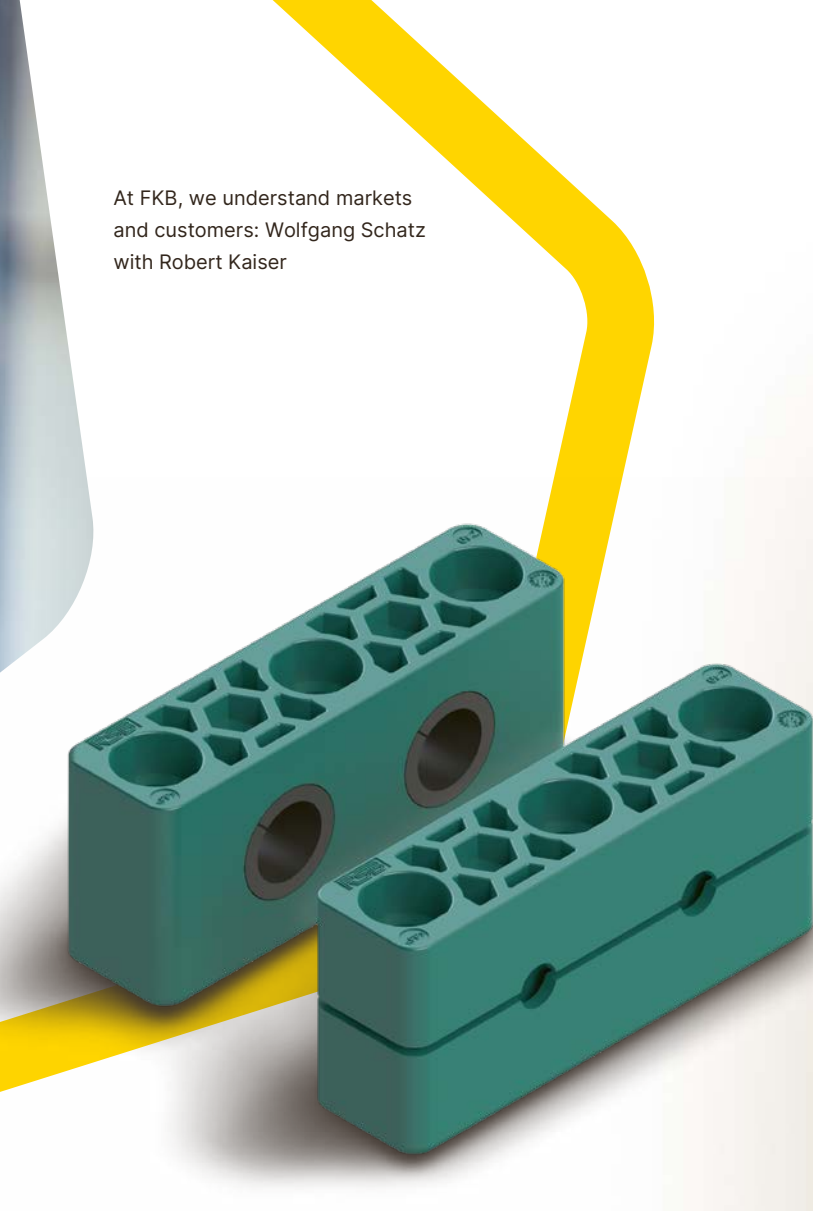

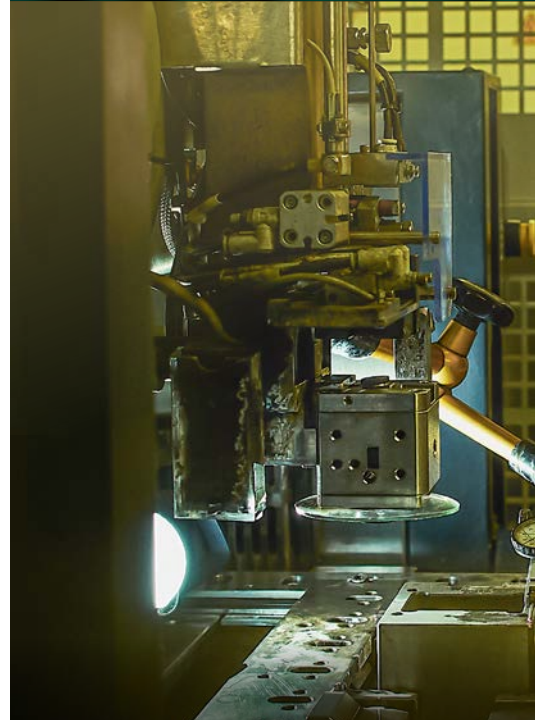

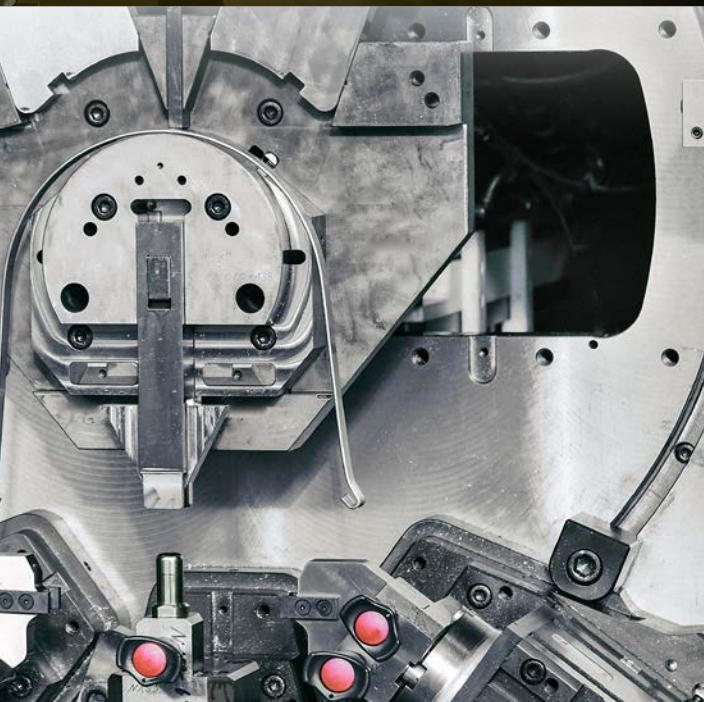
Plastic injection moulding technology

We utilise state-of-the-art injection moulding machines to produce according to specific customer requirements injection-moulded parts in single or multi-cavity moulds.



Stamping and forming technology

When it comes to high-quality and durable stamped and formed parts with maximum precision and efficiency, there is no way around FKB. We use state-of-the-art eccentric presses as well as stamping and bending machines to produce parts in all standard materials and surfaces. This also applies to sanitary technology. Whenever water and sprinkler systems are to be fixed with trapezoidal hangers, pipe loops and stabilizing clamps, renowned manufacturers rely on products from FKB. We advise and support our customers from the initial idea through design and toolmaking up to production.



In-house tool shop

This ensures not only maximum process reliability, but also short reaction times in the case of repeat orders or modifications. On the high seas

Whether cruise ship, luxury yacht, research and cargo ship or oil tanker: Wherever they are spotted, they cause a stir. In any case, they are impossible to ignore. The ocean liners are too big, too interesting and often too sublime. No matter how much these sea cruisers differ in purpose and appearance, what unites them all are the maximum safety standards applicable to ships. Also in terms of oil and water pipelines or electrical cables, of hydraulic systems that operate doors, bulkheads and hatches or in terms of securing lifeboats. No wonder then that leading shipyards worldwide, in exactly these areas, trust in RSB® block and tube clamps. Our clamps are known to defy wind, weather and waves. And they provide for optimal vibration isolation and noise protection, which also significantly enhances the comfort of crew and passengers.

For a long, healthy life

Algae are real powerhouses. These all-rounders contain many active ingredients as well as vital and anti-aging substances and are therefore used in pharmaceutical products as well as in food supplements and cosmetics. The vast majority of algae are, however, harvested from wild stocks which are often suffering from heavy pollution due to uncontrollable growth conditions. In contrast to those who come from the Austrian town Bruck, situated on the river Leitha. Here, on 10,000 square metres 100 tons of biomass are produced annually in the form of highly pure biologically and sustainably cultivated microalgae like Chlorella or Spirulina. This is made possible by 43,000 glass tubes, each of which is six metres in height and is firmly and absolutely food-safe and leak-proof anchored in the ground due to RSB® clamps.





Oh, how beautiful is Panama!

The Panama Canal is one of the most important waterways and is considered the eighth wonder of the world. Since its construction, ships no longer have to circumnavigate the entire continent, but can pass through the 82 km long waterway that connects the Atlantic with the Pacific Ocean. An enormous time and cost saving. In order to overcome the 26-metre height difference, up to 15,000 ships per year pass through a sophisticated system of hydraulic locks in which mounting rails, mounting rail nuts and clamps from RSB® are used.

Behind and under the scenes

A quick change of scenes from the Temple of Jerusalem to the Tower of Babel, with a beautiful garden in between or hundreds of actors, dressed in opulent costumes, who are staging the dramatic entanglement of love and power in a unique way. If classical music and opera - such as "Nabucco" - are intended to astound an audience not only acoustically, but also visually, main, secondary and revolving stages that are used for swift scene changes are indispensable for opera houses.
